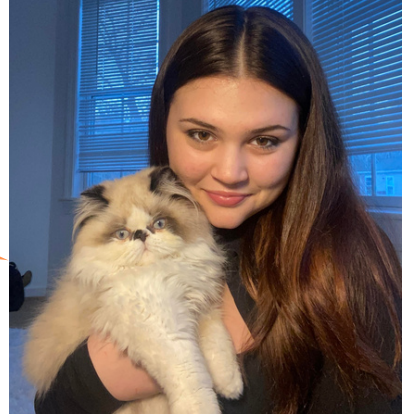




# The Gloucester Education Foundation 2022 Student Advisory Committee
